 II. 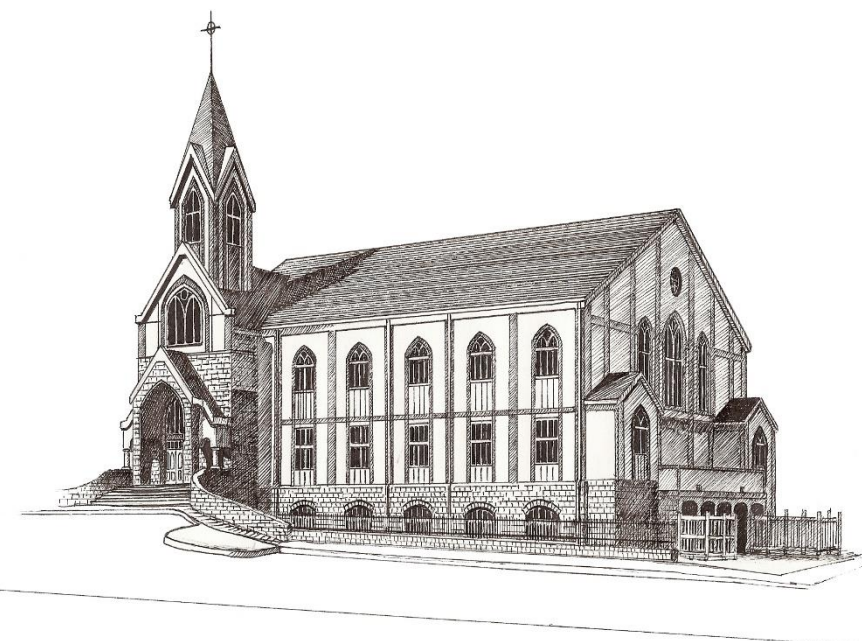
