Pastor: What do we pray for in the first petition?

Pastor: What do we pray for in the second petition?

People: In the second petition (which is, "Thy kingdom come") we pray, That Satan's kingdom may be destroyed; and that the kingdom of grace may be advanced, ourselves and others brought into it, and kept in it; and that the kingdom of glory may be hastened.

Pastor: What do we pray for in the sixth petition?
