Sermon Outline: Hebrews 11:23-29 – "Moses: Faith's Refusal"
Faith is the holy refusal to go along with the world or live by sight.

1. v.23: In faith, Moses' parents refused to go along.
2. v.24: Faith refuses worldly privilege and embraces divine adoption.
3. v.25: Faith refuses the pleasures of sin.
4. v.26: Faith refuses to elevate earthly treasures over divine reward.
5. v.27: Faith refuses to make decisions based on short-term fears, instead valuing perseverance and invisibility.
6. v.28: Faith refuses to rule out miracles.
7. v.29: Faith refuses to panic and abandon God.
